This course will involve 4 meetings during the Spring semester in order to prepare for the study abroad trip. The trip will include a day 10 visit to Santiago and Santo Domingo in the Dominican Republic (or other areas of the Dominican Republic) where students will observe and interact with students and teachers in public and private schools of all levels (pre-K through university level), with a specific focus on elementary schools. In addition to these experiences, students will have the opportunity to visit many cultural sites throughout the Dominican Republic and potentially participate in some outdoor activities (kayaking, ropes course, beach activities, etc.).
