Residence Halls

Students will live in one of two residence halls on campus. One residence hall is located on campus, and the other is 6kms from campus with public transportation available. Each residence hall has shared kitchens and cooking facilities for students.

Housing Stipend

Qualified Winthrop students may be eligible for a monthly stipend from Europe-Universitat Flensburg to assist with housing costs. Stipends can range between 350-700 Euros, and students should inquire directly to the international office in Flensburg.
