Apartment

Students live in comfortable, well-equipped apartments, a five-minute walk from the Fundación. Two to four students share an apartment, which includes single or double bedrooms, a bathroom, common living area and kitchen. Breakfast and weekly cleaning service are included in the program fee. There are numerous cafés and bars within walking distance.

Homestay

Students live in their own room in an Argentine home and become part of an Argentine family. The family provides two daily home-cooked meals, breakfast and dinner. Most homestay placements are within a 30-minute commute to the Fundación campus.
