What's a student visa?

A student visa is permission granted by a foreign government to live and study in that country. The type of visa required is specific to the length of your stay, citizenship, and the types of activities you will be engaged in. It is YOUR responsibility to determine specific visa requirements and stipulations, and apply for and acquire your student visa (if necessary) prior to the start of your program.
