Student Housing

Students can arrange to live in either The Varsity Apartments or UniCentral. Both offer comfortable, fully-furnished accommodations a short walk to the University (connected by pathways) with local shopping nearby. Student apartments are approximately a 20-minute bus ride to the beach. Both complexes offer fully-furnished apartments with private bedrooms and bathrooms and living and kitchen facilities shared with three other students. The complexes also offer amenities such as swimming pools, athletic courts, barbecue areas, and laundry.

After acceptance, students make accommodation arrangements on their own and pay housing fees directly to the accommodation providers.
